
How To - Use the Line Scan Images - Part 2: Quick-Prints

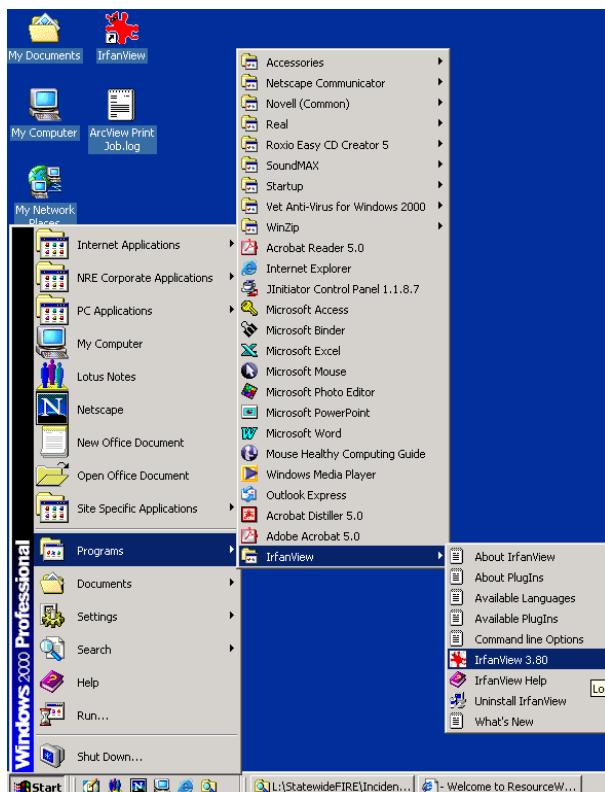
BACKGROUND

Having put all the linescan images (".jpeg" files) into the one directory, you can view them all as thumbnails in IrfanView 3.80. You can then quick-print multiple images after setting your printer correctly.

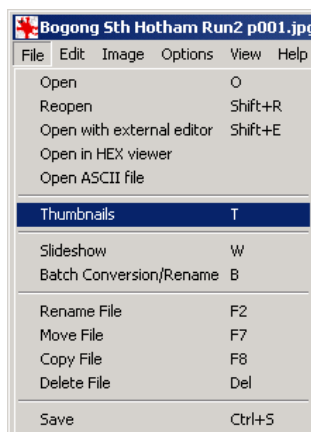
HOW DO I ...?

OPEN THE LINESCAN IMAGES AS THUMBNAILS

1. Go to **Start, Programs, IrfanView, IrfanView 3.80**

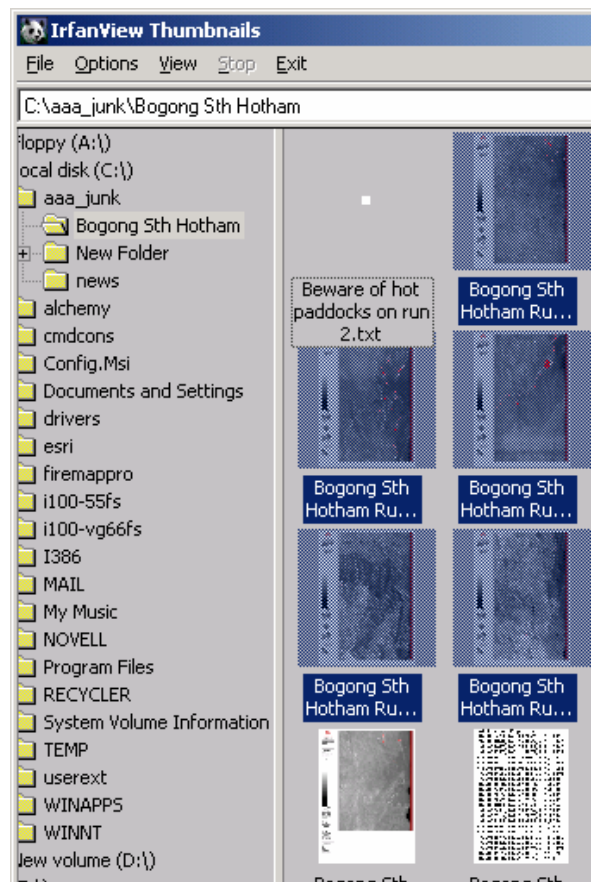


2. In IrfanView 3.80, **Click Edit, Thumbnails.**



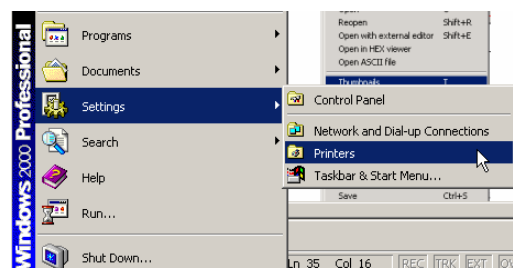
3. In the folders to the left, **Navigate** to where your linescan images (".jpeg" files) are stored.

The linescan images should now be viewable as thumbnails in the right panel with the folders accessible in the left panel, as shown below.



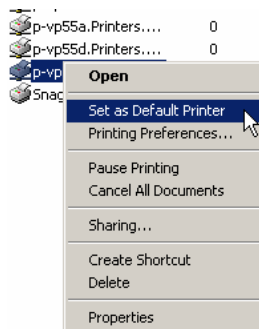
QUICK-PRINT THE LINESCAN IMAGES

4. Go to **Start, Settings, Printers**

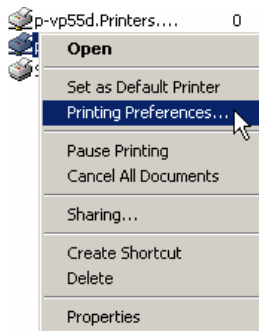


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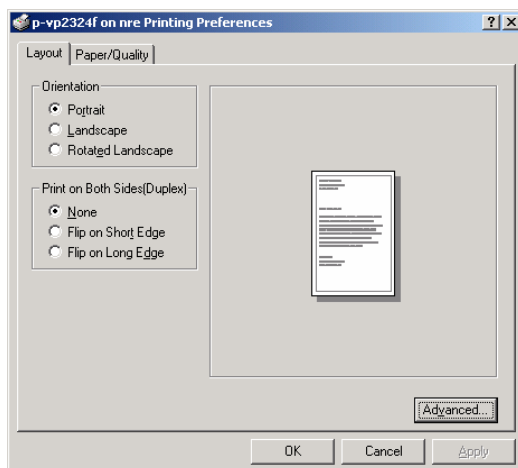
5. **Right-click** on your printer of choice (p-vp56g usually) and **Click “Set as Default Printer”**.



6. **Right-click** again on the printer and **Click “Printing Preferences”**.



7. Set Orientation as **Portrait**,

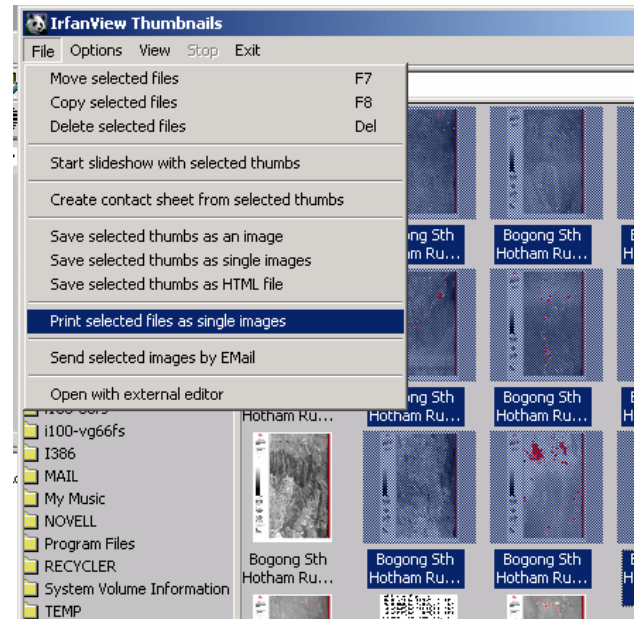


8. Click **Advanced...** and ensure the **Paper Size is A4**.



9. **Highlight the thumbnails** you wish to print by **holding CTRL** and **clicking** on the thumbnails.

10. **Click File, Print Selected Files As Single Image**



This will take you to the first image, and bring up the Print dialog. Check that the printing preferences are still correct (ie. A3 and Portrait) and print.
